# What to bring to the Dormitory

## NB! PLEASE MARK EVERYTHING WITH PERMANENT MARKER!

- ❖ School uniform and casual wear (see list)
- ❖ Spending money (± R100 per month) To be paid at the dormitory dean.
- ❖ Clothing-pegs
- ❖ **Clothes-hangers x 20 - To stay in dormitory**
- ❖ Torch
- ❖ Double adaptor
- ❖ Bedding (sheets, blankets or duvet, pillows)
- ❖ Toiletries: shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, face cloth
- ❖ Black shoe polish: shoe shine
